

ARTICLE 5.200 FIREWORKS†

Sec. 5.201 Definitions

The term "person" as used in this article is hereby defined to mean and include a person, firm, labor organizations, partnerships, associations, corporations, legal representatives, trustees in bankruptcy, or receivers. (2000 Code, sec. 5.201)

Sec. 5.202 Throwing or exploding fireworks unlawful

No person shall throw or explode any firecrackers, roman candles, skyrocketes, torpedoes, grenades, or any other combustible fireworks of any kind within the city limits. (2000 Code, sec. 5.202)

Sec. 5.203 Public or private demonstrations or displays

Nothing in this article shall prevent any public or private demonstrations or display of fireworks of any kind if conducted under proper police supervision after permission issued by the city, for such demonstration or display shall be of such a character, and so located, discharged or fired, as in the opinion of the city after proper inspection, shall not be hazardous to property or endanger any person or persons. (2000 Code, sec. 5.203)

Sec. 5.204 Restricted days and hours for demonstrations or displays

(a) Fireworks usage as regulated herein shall be restricted to 48 hours twice annually, said days being as follows:

- (1) The Fourth of July and the one (1) day preceding the Fourth of July; and
- (2) New Year's Day and the one (1) day preceding New Year's Day.

(b) One the second of the days as set forth herein, fireworks usage should cease not later than midnight.

Sec. 5.205 Penalty for violations

Any person in violation of this article shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined in accordance with the general penalty provision found in section 1.109 of this code. (2000 Code, sec. 5.205)
